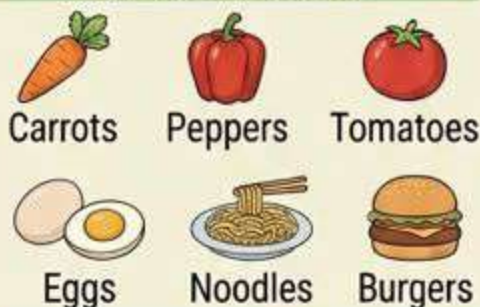

THE CORRECT LIST STRUCTURE

I like noodles, carrots, and peppers.

She ate an egg, some cheese, and a burger.

Use **commas** for 3+ items.
Use 'and' only before the last item!

DESCRIPTIVE WRITING: USING SENSORY WORDS

TASTE/FLAVOR
sweet, sour, delicious, yummy

APPEARANCE/TEXTURE
fresh, colorful, hot, cold

APPLICATION EXAMPLE
Basic Sentence:
"I eat soup."

Descriptive Sentence:
"I enjoy a bowl of hot, hot, delicious vegetable soup."
