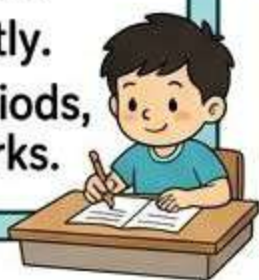

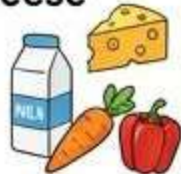
1 GRAMMAR & PUNCTUATION

USE OF COMMAS & "AND" IN LISTS

✗ **INCORRECT:** I like milk and cheese and carrots and peppers.

✓ **CORRECT:** I like milk, cheese, carrots**, and** peppers.

A clear note on placement before the last item.



SENTENCE STARTERS

T T here is some milk.

A A re there any eggs?

2 WRITING SENTENCES: QUANTITIES

(rec <IMAGE 0> and <IMAGE_1> vocabulary) vocabulary)

A. COUNTABLE FOODS

(Plural)



Positive: There are some tomatoes. ✓

Negative: There aren't any peppers. ✓

Use
SOME (+),
ANY (-)

B. UNCOUNTABLE FOODS

(Singular Form)



Positive: There's some chocolate. ✓

Negative: There isn't any water. ✓

Use
SOME (+),
ANY (-)

3 GUIDED PARAGRAPH: "MY FAVORITE FOOD"

1. INTRODUCE

2. DESCRIBE INGREDIENTS

3. ADD DETAILS/DRINKS

I like to drink some lemonade. It is delicious!



WRITING SUCCESS CRITERIA

- ✓ Started with Capital Letter & ended with Period/?.
- ✓ Used "some" for (+), "any" for (-).
- ✓ Used "and" only before the last item in a list.
- ✓ Spelled country names with Capital Letter (e.g., China).

1. HOW TO WRITE A SIMPLE RECIPE



Part A: THE INGREDIENT LIST

- Two eggs
- A glass of milk
- Some flour



Focus on Imperative Verbs (Commands)



Part B: STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wash tomatoes/peppers.
2. Chop vegetables.
3. Heat oil in pan.
4. Mix everything together.



2. STRUCTURING A SHORT FOOD REVIEW



O.R.E.O. Paragraph Strategy

Letter	Part of Paragraph	Writing Example
O	Opinion (State your view) 	My absolute favorite meal is... chicken soup.
R	Reason (Why you like it) 	It tastes incredibly savory...
E	Explanation/Example 	My mom adds carrots, noodles, and some pepper...
O	Opinion Restated 	If you've never tried it, you're missing out...

Correct O. Paragraph Template

Incorrect plurals

tomato's
potato's

Correct plurals

tomatoes
potatoes

+oes for words ending in -o!

Missing list commas

cheese burger
milk and
lemonade

cheese*,
milk, and
lemonade

Lowercase countries

italian pizza

Capitalized countries

Italian pizza



WRITING SUCCESS CRITERIA

- ✓ Recipe divided into Ingredients & Numbered Steps.
- ✓ Steps start with action verbs (Chop, Pour, Bake)
- ✓ Correct commas in lists (..., ..., and ...).
- ✓ Plural spellings (tomatoes, sandwiches).
